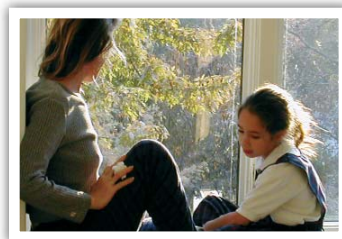


## GETTING THE BEST FROM YOUR AIR CONDITIONER

- Keep windows and doors closed – also close your drapes and curtains during hot summer days. You can reduce heat absorption by up to 80%
- When a hot day is expected, turn your system on early rather than waiting for the heat to build up
- Keep the fan speed on low to medium if possible as the high position is really only for when the unit first comes on or under extreme conditions
- When cooling, position the vents or louvers of the air discharge in the up position for the cool air to mix quickly with the warmer air that rises. The reverse applies when heating
- Clean filters regularly. Air flow and cooling efficiency can be reduced by over 50% due to blocked or dirty filters
- Don't try and have the room freezing cold or boiling hot but aim for comfort. The average "comfort level" for most people is 23°C
